Pilot Conservation Advice Scheme for Vacant Traditional Farmhouses

Please Note The Following

- Form must be fully completed and submit to <u>niah@housing.gov.ie</u> along with accompanying photos and relevant documents. Applications should not exceed 10mb.
- **Digital photographs** of the farmhouse to be provided. Minimum of 5 to be submitted and labelled with short description of the content. Photographs should include exterior (front & rear), site/context; significant interior, out-buildings etc.
- Please type in the relevant information, if possible.
- If handwritten, please use **BLOCK CAPITALS** or ensure script is legible along with labelled hard copy photographs.
- Where a grant is made, the address of the building to be surveyed may be displayed on the Department's website in line with our policy for all conservation grants.
- The scheme is not limited to Protected Structures or historic structures located within an Architectural Conservation Area. It includes traditionally constructed buildings which do not have statutory protection. 'Traditionally constructed' is taken, but not exclusively understood, to mean buildings constructed of stone or mud (or combination of these materials) with lime and/or earth mortars. If the building is a protected structure the RPS Reference number can be found on the Record of Protected Structures (RPS) of the relevant local authority. The list of Architectural Conservation Areas can be found in the current Local Authority Development Plan. These documents are available to search online; alternatively, the local authority Architectural Conservation Officer can provide advice.
- The building must be a Vacant Traditional Farmhouse (see brief for applicants for further explanation).
